BC Mental Health and Substance Use Services (BCMHSUS) provides provincial specialized assessment and treatment services for people with complex care needs. This includes individuals facing challenges related to mental health, substance use, and/or development disability, or criminal justice system involvement.

Correctional Health Services

We provide a continuum of healthcare services across all 10 provincial correctional facilities, providing clients with primary health care as well as mental health and substance use supports. Additionally, 10 interdisciplinary Community Transition Teams provide bridging services to clients as they transition from custody to community.

Forensic Psychiatric Services

Our 190-bed secure Forensic Psychiatric Hospital in Coquitlam specializes in treating individuals found not criminally responsible or unfit to stand trial due to a mental disorder. Our 7 regional clinics across British Columbia provide comprehensive care for those with legal issues and complex mental health and substance use challenges.

- Red Fish Healing Centre for Mental Health & Addiction
 Our state-of-the-art 105-bed facility in Coquitlam plays a
 crucial role in our mission to deliver recovery and treatment
 services for individuals with complex substance use and
 mental health issues.
- Heartwood Centre for Women
 Located in Vancouver, Heartwood Centre for Women is a 30-bed facility that provides integrated treatment for individuals living with severe substance use and mental health issues.
- Provincial Assessment Centre
 A 10-bed facility in Coquitlam and outpatient services provide multi-disciplinary mental health services for individuals with a developmental disability and a concurrent mental illness or behaviour issue.
